

Calendar feed through iMac

Follow the below steps to have an internet calendar show up in the **iCal** of your iMac.

1) Open **iCal** :

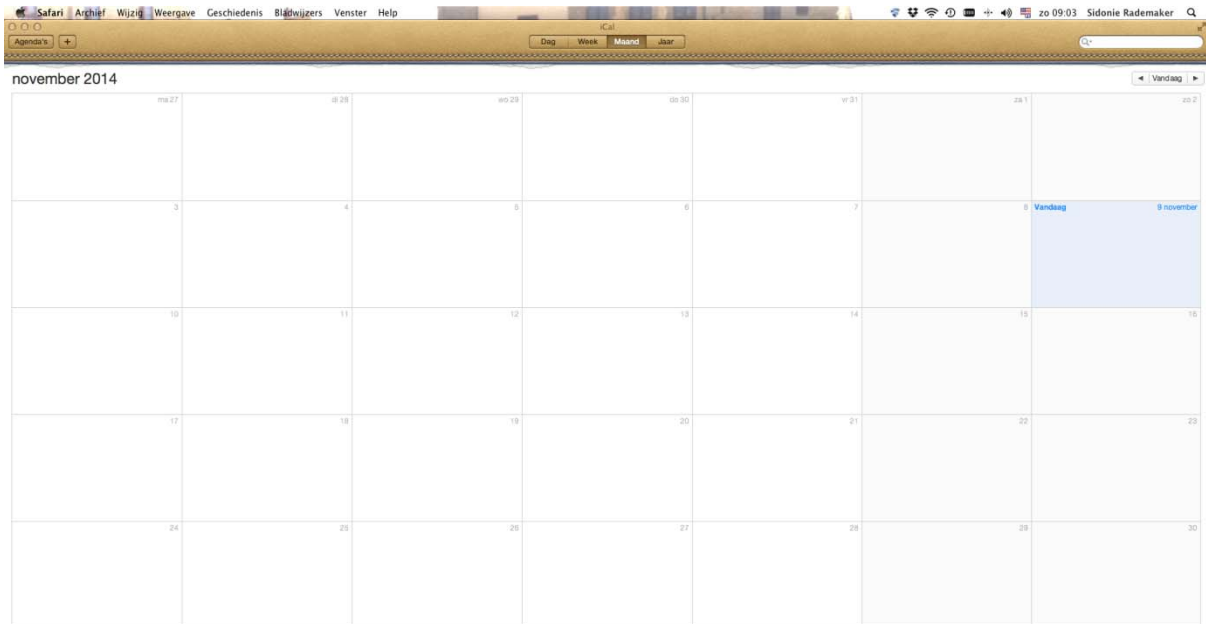


Figure 1: open iCal

2) Tap **Calendar** followed by **Subscribe to Calendar** :

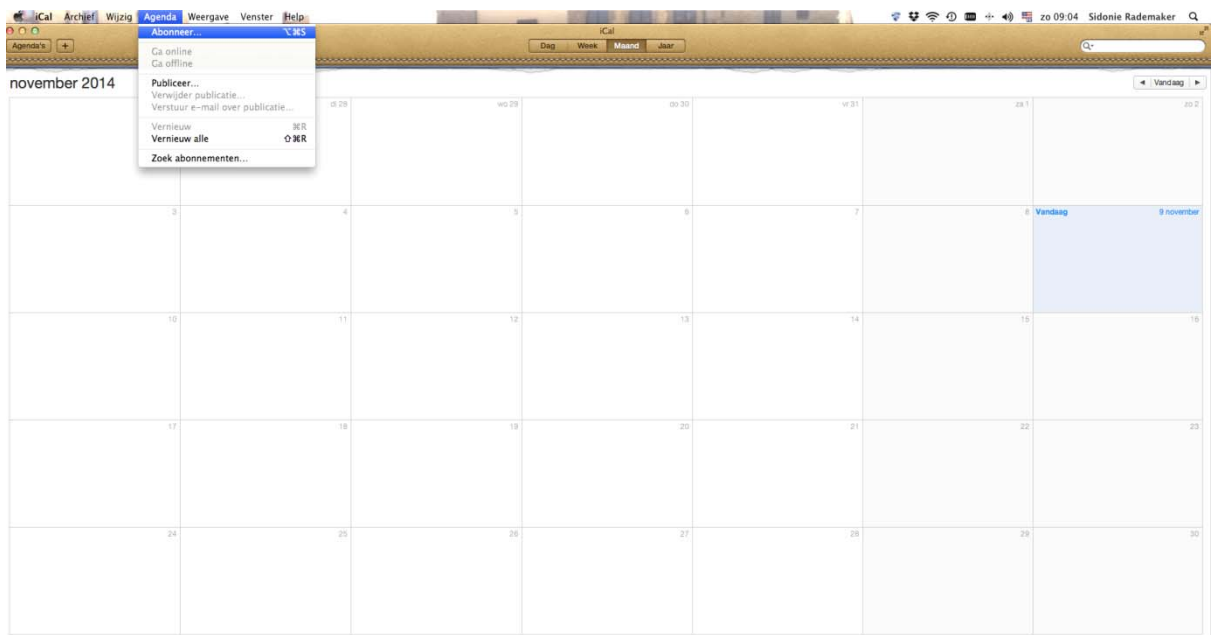


Figure 2: Subscribe to Calendar

3. Paste the address (ending with .ics) of the calendar in the opening window and confirm by tapping on **Subscribe** :

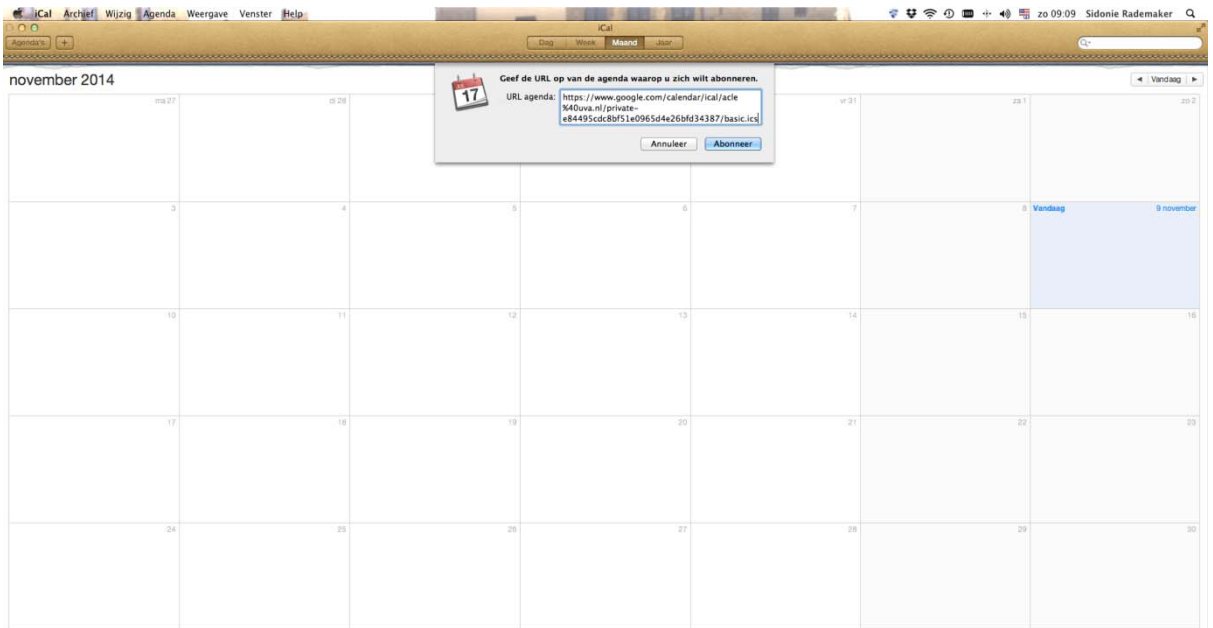


Figure 3: Adding Internet Calendar path and subscribe to calendar

- Before finishing, you can give the calendar a meaningful name in the **Description** then tap **ok** once done:

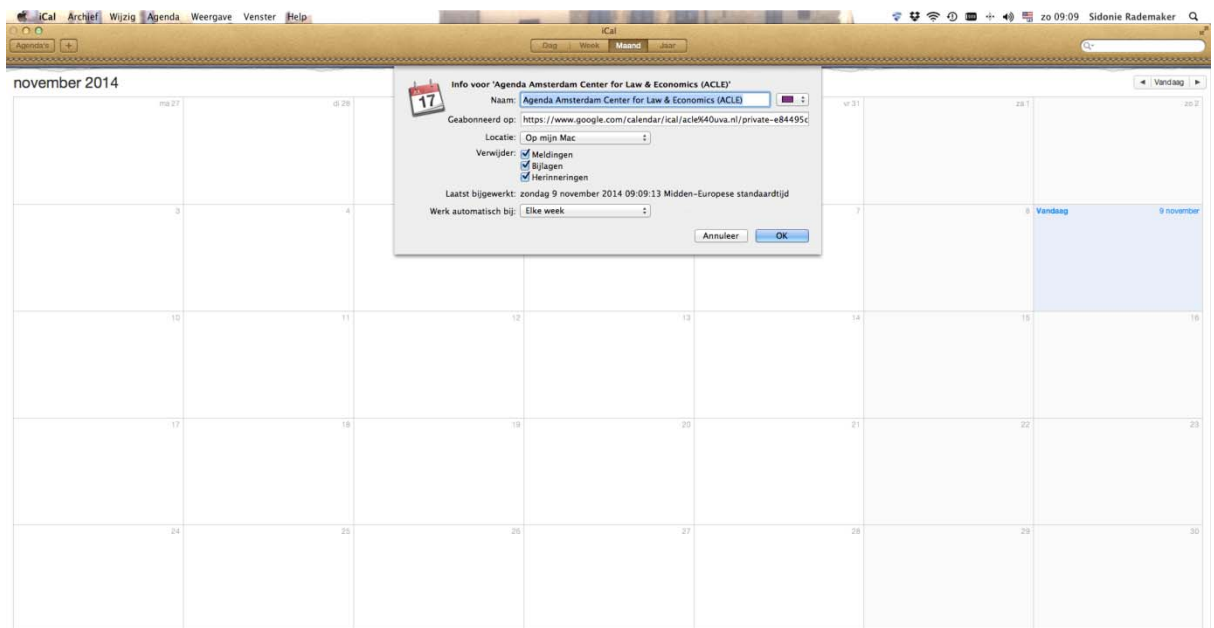


Figure 4: Providing a meaningful description

The newly added calendar will now be available in the **iCal** and its entries will show up with a specific colour to differentiate them from other calendar entries.

Please Note: it is possible to view the calendar combined (all calendars merged into one) or split into separate calendars.

As you would normally do with your personal calendar, you can change among different "views" like **daily**, **weekly**, or **monthly**.
