ACLE Visiting Scholars

<u>Damla Gül Tarhan</u> (January 2023 – January 2024) is Specialist at the Central Bank of Turkey. During her visit, Tarhan will work on her project "The Application of Non-Financial Reporting in Turkish Capital Market Law: Lessons from the European Union Directive on Non-Financial Reporting".

<u>Zohar Goshen</u> (1 July – 14 July 2023) is the Jerome L. Greene Professor of Transactional Law at Columbia Law School. During his visit, Goshen will work on corporate governance, sustainability, and the law and he will teach in the <u>Amsterdam-Columbia</u> summer program.
