Necessity of digital evidence gathering

Change from an analogue to a digital society

- some information never existed on paper
- some paper information will be destroyed
- information on paper is limited to the content



egal provisions

- No specific legal provisions in national laws
- Interpretation of existing legal provisions
- Practise following on "analogue evidence gathering"



Legal provision: Dutch Example

- Look into business information and documents
 - (5:17 General Administrative Law act)
- No limitation to analogue document but also information in electronic format ¹

_imitations

- Business information documents (not private)
- Proportionate (no fishing expedition)
 - (art. 5: 13 General Administrative Law Act)
- No legally privileged information
 - (art. 51 competition Act)

Extract private and legally privileged documents at the NMa (based on notice and attendance of Lawyer)

Search query (in attendance of Lawyer)

Hit – list available for the company
